The meeting was called to order at 6:03 PM by Chair Tom Johnson.

The correspondence from David Skiba regarding the offer of property for purchase as open space was noted. The letter was also sent to the Open Space Committee.

It was moved by Johnson and seconded by Wade to return unused monies from Article 19 of the 2009 Annual Town Meeting and Article 34 of the 2010 Annual Town Meeting to the Historic Reserve account (motion attached). Voted 7-0.

The CPA committee discussed contacting recipients of CPA funds to get status reports.

The CPA Committee discussed the votes at the Special Town Meeting that re-allocated funds for affordable housing. The Committee voted 7-0 that the Housing Trust consider the purchase of the Catholic Church property on Massasoit Road and the property that abuts Town Hall immediately to the south on Route 6. Moved Cookson, seconded Johnson, voted 7-0.


On November 15, 2011, the CPA Committee will hold a public informational hearing to solicit proposals for projects that qualify for CPA finding.
