Eastham Transfer Station Campaigning Procedures

February 19, 2013

In order to maintain public safety and order at the Eastham Solid Waste Transfer Station, the following rules are observed:

- Campaigning shall be limited to holding signs and handing printed and written materials. Signs may be held in the area located near the textile recycling area exiting the transfer station. This area is located before passing the scale house on the way out of the Transfer Station.
- Unattended signs are not permitted on the Transfer Station site.
- All campaigning shall be conducted during the posted operating hours at the Transfer Station. Campaigners shall notify the transfer gate attendant when entering the facility - all Transfer Station sticker rules apply.
- Campaigning consists of showing support or opposition for candidates or issues listed on a Town of Eastham election ballot or Town Meeting warrant. Campaigning shall be conducted in a civil manner without public disruption or breach of the peace.
- Vehicles shall not block the road.
- Campaigning activities shall not block traffic or motorists' visibility.
- There shall be no campaigning at any other area in the transfer station including, but not limited to, the swap shop, recycle area, metal pile, construction debris area, or the leaf pile.
- Food or beverages may not be served to the public at the transfer station.
- Staff decisions in enforcing this policy are final and not subject to debate.
