This Saturday, September 27th Our Final National Prescription Drug Take Back Day!

Here's your last chance to easily and safely dispose of your unwanted or expired prescription drugs. Drop them off at your local police station who will dispose of them safely. Over the last 5 years, more than 4 million pounds of drugs have been collected through this program.

When?

This Saturday, September 27, 2014
10 am to 2 pm

Where?

The police department in every town on the Cape.

Why?

To prevent drugs from being flushed down the drain and into our wastewaters and to remove them from our medicine cabinets where they can be misused.

What's Next?

Under new regulations, retail pharmacies will be able to install collection boxes, allowing you to dispose of your unwanted drugs throughout the year. However, these regulations have just been approved this month and it may take some time before the collection boxes become widely available.
