

EASTHAM CONSERVATION COMMISSION

January 16, 1991

The Eastham Conservation Commission, acting under the provisions of Chapter 40, §8c of the General Laws, hereby adopts the following rules and regulations governing the use of land administered by the Eastham Conservation Commission, which rules were originally adopted on January 16, 1991.

1. The public is welcome to enjoy the conservation areas of Eastham from one-half hour before sunrise until one-half hour after sunset unless otherwise posted.
2. No person shall engage in business, sell, expose for sale, or give away any goods or circulars unless suitably licensed and then only in public parking areas in accordance with applicable law.
3. Unposted areas may be fished or hunted in season by licensed persons in accordance with applicable law with the following exception: no hunting shall be permitted in the South Eastham Conservation Area (also known as the Lamont Smith property).
4. In conservation areas, no person shall cut, break, remove, deface, defile or misuse any structure, fence, or sign, or remove any part thereof. Growing trees, bushes, plants and flowers shall not be defaced, defiled or cut. No trails shall be marked or cut. No dams, or any structures such as lean-tos, bridges, towers, or handrails shall be constructed without authorization of the Conservation Commission. Fruit may be harvested.
5. Littering or discarding refuse on conservation land is prohibited. Refuse generated as a result of recreational activities must be removed.
6. No alcoholic beverages shall be permitted at any time.
7. Open fires are not allowed.
8. Over-night camping is no permitted except by organizations who have an adult leader present at all times and who have applied for and received written permission from the Eastham Conservation Commission.
9. No person or vehicle of any kind will be permitted on coastal dunes except in designated areas.
10. No cars, trucks, or other powered vehicles (including mopeds) except municipal vehicles are allowed except on designated roads. Use of power tools is prohibited except by special Conservation Commission permission.
11. Violations of the above shall be punishable be fines of not less than \$10 for a first offense, not less than \$25 for a second offense and not less than \$50 for a third or subsequent offense.
