

DO YOU QUALIFY FOR ANY OF THESE PROGRAMS?

Property Tax Exemption (Application is made beginning in August of each year.)

Elderly Person

1. 65 years or over as of July 1, 2012
2. MA resident for 10 years, MA property owner for last 5 years
3. Gross income less than \$24,158 if single, \$36,237 if married
4. Assets less than \$40,000 if single, \$55,000 if married (house & car not included)

Disabled Veteran

1. Veterans Administration Certificate required if disabled
2. Purple Heart recipient (even if not disabled)
3. Surviving spouses of disabled veterans and veterans with Purple Hearts may be eligible for this exemption.

Blind Person (MA Commission for the Blind Certificate required)

Medicare Buy In Programs

QMB (includes refund of Medicare premium, pays deductibles and co-payments)

Income below \$931/month for an individual

Income below \$1261/month for a couple

Resource (assets) limit \$6,940/individual, \$11,910/couple
(House, personal possessions, car not included)

SLMB (refund of Medicare premium)

Income below \$1117/month for an individual

Income below \$1513/month for a couple

Resource (assets) limit \$6,940/individual, \$11,910/couple
(House, personal possessions, car not included)

QI-1 (refund of Medicare premium)

Income below \$1257/month for an individual

Income below \$1702/month for a couple

Resource (assets) limit \$6,940/individual, \$11,910/couple
(House, personal possessions, car not included)

Health Safety Net (Assists with some services at a hospital or Community Health

Income below \$1815/month for an individual

Center)

Income below \$2452/month for a couple

No Asset Test

Fuel Assistance (Benefit amounts vary with income and type of fuel)

1. Gross income must be below:

	2	\$40,824
	3	\$50,429
	4	\$60,035

2. Discount on base rate of telephone, gas and electric bills if qualify for Fuel Assistance.

3. Assistance with repair or replacement of heating units through Housing Assistance Corporation.
