RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR KITE BOARDING/WINDSURFING

- 1) No kites/equipment are allowed to be unattended on the beach or in the water.
- 2) Kite boarders/windsurfers must set-up and launch from the designated area (Identified by signage on beach)
- 3) Kite boarders/windsurfers in the water must stay 200 feet beyond the inner buoy at all times when not launching or returning to launch area.
- 4) No KiteBoarding/Windsurfing on Bees River from June 15 to Labor Day.
- 5) No Kite Boarders/Windsurfers are allowed near people or within restricted areas.
- 6) All Kite boarders/windsurfers must identify themselves at the Gate House. They will subsequently be directed to the appropriate area and given written regulations.
- 7) No rigging is allowed nor shall occur within the dunes at any beach, or in the parking area.
- 8) Kite boarders/windsurfers must yield to beach-goers and swimmers.

The Board of Selectmen, or their designee, may close First Encounter Beach or any beach if they feel conditions are unsafe for kite boarders, windsurfers, beach-goers, swimmers, etc.

The above regulations do not pertain to Great Pond.
