SAFETY ON EXISTING ROADS

1. Encourage the Town of Eastham and the Cape Cod National Seashore to consider adequate bike lanes on each side of the road when improvements are made to any primary road (artery) in Eastham. Of special concern are those roads that lead to or connect bike trails.
2. Work with the Town and CCNS to better mark the route from Salt Pond Visitor Center to the CCRT crossing on Locust Road
3. Select and mark safe Route 6 crossings on Bike Trails maps.
4. Plan and install signage for any new parking areas or bike routes.

PARKING FOR CYCLISTS

1. Continue study of available parking for cyclists and identify new locations for development of a safe parking area with signage, bike racks, adequate lighting, toilet facilities and drinking water.
2. Survey and recommend routes from existing parking to the CCRT.

RECREATION AREAS FOR CYCLISTS

1. Develop rest/picnic areas on town land along the CCRT and any other bike trails that are developed.
2. Develop off-road cycling routes within town properties

EDUCATION

1. Review and update available information produced by the town, Chamber of Commerce and others that show roads, sights, trails, parking, CCRT milemarkers, toilet facilities, etc. Include written safety requirements and suggestions wherever possible.
2. Continue involvement with Mass Biking Coalition and other biking organizations to ensure that our committee stays current with trends and issues impacting state and local concerns. These would include environmental and health concerns as well as encouraging cycling when possible due to the energy crisis.
3. Be available as a resource for any biking safety teaching opportunities within the town.

FUNDING

1. Consider potential funding needs and sources for funds to enhance the impact of the Eastham Bikeways Committee.
