Cape Cod Bay

The Rock Harbor, Boat Meadow, Bee's River and Hatches Creeks, inside of lines drawn across the mouth of each, are **CLOSED** for the taking of all shellfish.

Nauset Estuary

1. Abelino's Creek, inside a line drawn across the mouth, is **CLOSED** for the taking of shellfish
2. The east side of Salt Pond and the Salt Pond River are **CLOSED** for the taking of shellfish.
3. The west side of Salt Pond is open **SUNDAYS** only subject to an annual schedule and rotating area. The Salt Pond is open to *family limits* only. The schedule can be found on the town website as well as posted at the Salt Pond on Saturday.
4. The area from points marked on the bank with signs starting behind Goose Hummock and continuing northeasterly for 500ft, out 150ft into Town Cove is **CLOSED** to the taking of shellfish.
5. The area 1000ft to the north and 1000ft to the south of Hemenway Landing is open to FAMILY LIMITS for mussels only.
