Participants:

-  Teams limited to 6 participants.
-  Participants may not be on multiple teams.
-  Teams will be divided in the following 5 categories:
 -  Kids – Ages 12 and under
 -  Teens – Ages 13 to 18
 -  Adults – Ages 19 and up
 -  Family
 -  Business




Tips:

-  Have a plan before starting.
-  Pack your sand hard and use lots of water.
-  Use stacks or mounds of very wet sand then carve your desired shape.
-  To get the best density build up your structure gradually.
-  Be creative
-  **HAVE FUN!**

Rules:

-  Piles of sand must be formed by manpower only.
-  The use of shovels, hoes, spatulas and other tools (except power tools) are permitted.
-  Sand Sculptures must consist of sand only with the exception of wood, rocks, shells, etc., found on the beach the day of the contest and used as decorations only. No glass may be used.
-  Participants must **STAY AWAY** from the dunes. Please **DO NOT** use any dune grass.
-  Sand forms (flower pots, milk cartons, buckets, etc.) may be used, but only as forms.
-  Sculptures may not be dampened or sprayed with any solutions other than water. **NO STICKY STUFF!**
-  To be judged, your sand art must be confined within the assigned space and must follow the ‘Under The Sea’ theme.

Judging:

-  Sculptures must be finished by 1:30 pm when judging begins.
-  A panel of judges will decide the winners for each category.
-  Winners will be announced at the beach.
