VESSEL STORAGE LOTTERY RULES

*Vessel storage permits are solely reserved for Eastham tax-payers or year-round residents renting property in Eastham. Entries **SHALL** include the Eastham residential address to become eligible, others (including PO Boxes) **will not** be accepted.*

- 1) Individual drawings will be held for each of the 5 locations where the Town of Eastham is offering vessel storage. The amount of spots offered at each location is as follows:
 - a. Hemenway Landing: 5 spots for people with disabilities, 45 additional spots
 - b. Great Pond: 2 spots for people with disabilities, 18 additional spots
 - c. Boat Meadow: 2 spots for people with disabilities, 18 additional spots
 - d. Salt Pond: 2 spots for people with disabilities, 10 additional spots
 - e. Sunken Meadow: 2 spots for people with disabilities, 10 additional spots
- 2) Households interested in taking part in the lottery will be allowed to participate in up to 2 separate drawings only:
 - a. One at their Primary Location of interest
 - b. A second Alternate Location in the event that their number is not drawn at their primary location (only if said location has availability after awarding spots to those who chose it as their primary location)
- 3) Per the Town of Eastham's Vessel Storage Regulations and Policies Section 4.9, vessels shall be placed at only one location. Therefore, as soon as a lottery number comes up during any of the drawings, it immediately becomes ineligible for the rest of the drawings (even if the same number comes up again)
- 4) Per the Town of Eastham's Vessel Storage Regulations and Policies Section 4.10, participants will only be considered for up to 2 spots per location (2 at their Primary Location and 2 at their Alternate Location) per household.
- 5) Multiple entries per household are not allowed. In the event this occurs, only the first entry will be considered
- 6) Households chosen as part of the drawings will receive an application to submit via email:
 - a. There will be a \$50 charge per spot
 - b. Those applying for a spot for a disabled person must provide vehicle placard information to verify their disabled status
- 7) A total of 10 additional numbers will be drawn at each location beyond the amount of spots available. This will create a waiting list at each location in the event that participants who are chosen are not able to, or decline to, apply for their spots
- 8) Interested participants will be allowed to enter the lottery starting at 3:00 pm. February 15th until 3:00 pm. March 15th.
