Town of Eastham's Re-Opening Plan

(Eastham, MA) – The Town offices remain open with virtual, remote, and on-line services, and beginning this weekend (May 28th) will transition to in-person public services. *Masks and physical distancing will continue to be required inside any public buildings.* The schedule for the month of June is as follows:

Beach Sticker Office - will re-open Friday May 28th at 9 am and be open through Sunday 9am to 3 pm (closed on Memorial Day). Then will be open on their regular schedule, Thursdays through Mondays from 9 am to 3 pm every week.

Eastham Public Library will re-open four days per week beginning on June 2. Please go to the Library website easthamlibrary.org for more information on hours and dates, or phone (508) 240-5950.

Town Hall will re-open to the public on Monday, June 14, 8 am to 4 pm (7am for inspectors) and will be open three days per week, Monday, Tuesday & Thursdays from 8 am to 4 pm.

The Swap Shop will open the week of June 14, but *will be restricted to vehicles with transfer station stickers only*

Senior Center is being painted and generally spruced up thanks to the dedication of the Council on Aging Board and will re-open to the public on a limited schedule TBA the week of June 28. Senior Center programs will return in July. For more information, please phone the senior center directly at (508) 255-6164.

The Town will continue to assess the public health environment and may make changes to public access to Town facilities based on best practice guidance. We will update the plan prior to July 1.
